Regarding attendance and scoring for the seminar course

% Notes for Attendance :

- A. Classes are scheduled to be held in either the EC6019 (Department of Electrical Engineering), EC2002 (Institute of Communications Engineering) or EC1001 (Institute of IC Design) of the Building of Electrical Engineering, please refer to the weekly announcements.
- B. Although most of the speeches in the department/Institute are conducted in Chinese, if there are any sessions conducted in English, please make sure to attend those first. Only if you still have unmet attendance requirements after attending the available English sessions, you may then choose lectures from other departments or online. Both in-person and pre-recorded online lectures are acceptable, but please ensure that the sessions you select are relevant to your research field.
- C. If you are attending an in-person lecture, please do not wear tank tops or flip-flops as a sign of respect for the speaker, and avoid entering late to ensure the smooth progress of the seminar.

Scoring:

Item A: Every student must attend at least six seminars within one semester and handwrite a feedback report for each. Report sheets can be obtained from the departmental office.

Unless otherwise specified when submitting your reports, the first six reports will be scored according to <u>Item B</u>, and up to five additional reports will be scored according to <u>Item C</u>. If you attend an in-person seminar, it will be prioritized for scoring under <u>Item B</u> before any online seminar.

Item B:

For each seminar attended and corresponding report submitted, you will receive 10 points for attendance and 0–7 points for the report (The report score consists of 4 points for content and 3 points for the word count in English).

- ♦ The following situations will receive zero points (the session will be regarded as unscored): completely blank reports, written by another person, copied articles from the Internet, complete copy of the speaker's slides (must include personal comments to earn points), copying reports from other students, content completely unrelated to the speech, Report not submitted by 17:00 on the same day of the seminar.
- ♦ English word count scoring (including punctuation):

✓ 0 points: fewer than 60 words

✓ 1 points : 61-80 words

✓ 2 points: 81-100 words

✓ 3 points : 101 words or more

Item C:

If you attend more than six seminars, you may earn **1 point for attendance** and **0–7 points for the report** for each additional seminar, up to a maximum of five extra seminars. If more than five extra reports are submitted, only the first five additional seminars will be counted.

Item D:

- ♦ If you attend an in-person seminar, please submit your handwritten report to the TA in the classroom after the seminar. You can collect your report sheet from the departmental office before your next seminar.
- ♦ If you attend online seminars during the semester, you may prepare the reports in advance and submit them to the departmental office the next time you attend an in-person seminar.
- ♦ The final submission deadline is by the end of Week 16 of the semester. Please make sure your handwriting is clear and legible.
